1. The student is typically a senior, unless the accomplishments of a junior far exceed those of the most eligible senior.
2. The student is typically chosen by the principal and a small committee of teachers and counselors.
3. The volunteer work that is done must be outside of normal school hours.
4. Children of members from the Rotary Club of Andover are not eligible.
5. We rely on facts and numbers that describe the degree of service to the organizations and causes to which the student contributed. Please be as specific as possible about the amount of time and effort put into each service activity.
6. **The deadline for submission is February 28.**
