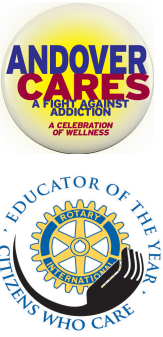


Where Doing Good is Serious Fun

The Rotary Club of Andover (Rotary) has been supporting groups and initiatives in and around Andover for the past 25 years. We are a part of Rotary International, with 1.3 million members worldwide.

In the past, these events have raised over \$40,000. The funds raised during these events will support charities and causes through grants awarded to carefully screened recipients. Over 90% of our grants support local causes in Andover with a small percentage to international projects sponsored and managed by Rotarians.
