Once our device was made, we had to present our device and explain how it functions in front of some of the prosthetic and orthotic lecturers. Both myself and my partner were very impressed, as were our lecturers and we received full marks which was very exciting. I am very grateful to be given the opportunity to study at La Trobe University and am also very excited for what the next semester has to offer.
