Tony Marseglia Teacher Mini-Grant Program

The Hackensack Rotary Tony Marseglia Teacher Mini-grant program provides small grants to educators in the Hackensack Public Schools to assist with implementing an innovative project in their classroom.

- 1. Individual grants shall not exceed five hundred dollars (\$250) and a teacher is only eligible for one grant per year.
- Funds may be used to purchase equipment, materials, supplies or contracted services. The funds may
 not be used for salaries or to supplant expenses normally provided for in the regular school budget.
 The purpose of the grant is to support educators in implementing a special project that is not
 supported in the regular school budget.
- 3. Completed applications shall include all pertinent information and a signature of your principal or department head indicating approval of the project is needed.
- 4. Funds shall be disbursed, payable to the school, after the club has received confirmation from your Principal accepting the grant and an assurance that the funds will be used as indicated in the grant application.
- 5. Grant recipients agree to submit a written report / thank you note with photographs of the project upon its completion.
- 6. Applications can be submitted to Hackensack Rotary via Katie Zoch at Kathryn.zoch@gmail.com.
- 7. Applications are being accepted on a rolling basis until April 1, or until all funds are exhausted, whichever comes first.
- 8. Grant approvals should be expected about 30 days after submission.
