
### VOLUNTEER ACTIVATION

**Rotary is dedicated to causes that build relationships, improve lives, and create a better world.**

Each year, a portion of the funds raised are reserved for our larger "Service Above Self" grants. The grant cycle occurs every few years after a significant pool of funds has been raised.

Examples of large grants include the \$100,000 funding cycle this year, split between Hope Alliance, Holy Cross Ministries and Peace House. In the past we've provided **\$50,000** for the Children's Justice Center, **\$50,000** for Bright Futures, and **\$25,000** for PC Tots.
