1. Non-Profit Corporation that supports Rotary International.
2. Celebrated 100th Anniversary in 2016,
3. District 7910 raised \$205,000 to the Annual Fund. Endowments and major gifts raised \$1,324,000.
4. Goal in 2017-2018 is to generate \$300,000 for the Annual Fund, and a 2-year total of \$2,000,000 for major gifts and endowment.
5. Charitynavigator.org rates TRF with 4 stars (highest level). Overall rating 98%.
6. 91% of funds are spent directly on programs.
7. Annual Gifts help people live better lives today.
8. A gift to Rotary's Endowment supports programs forever.
9. If you include Rotary Foundation in your estate plan, your gift can be restricted to World Fund, share (which comes back to the District), one of 6 areas of focus: Disease and prevention (including polio), peace and conflict prevention/resolution, water and sanitation, maternal and child health, basic education and literacy, economic and community development, Rotary Peace Centers.
10. You can fund a bequest by your will or living trust, retirement plan beneficiary designation, life insurance beneficiary designation, and donor advised fund, charitable remainder trust, directly from retirement plan required minimum distribution (RMD).
