WR Township Update

Wood River Township Supervisor, Mike Babcock, was our speaker last week. Mike is a life-long area resident who was raised in Rosewood heights and received degrees from LCCC and SIUE in Electronics. He was elected to the office of Township Supervisor 2.5 years ago.

Make has made four commitments as supervisor and is making progress on all four.

1. Cut government spending.

Under Mike's leadership the township budget is balanced and running a surplus, even in a difficult economy. He has eliminated a lot of waste in the budget.

2. Reduce property Taxes

Under Mike's leadership the tax levy has been lowered 1.5%. It's not much, but it's a start.

3. Better Communication

4. Job Creation

Due to the loss of manufacturing, the township is down by 20,000-30,000 jobs. In order to bring new jobs to the area, Mike is proposing a five part strategy to change the environment.
