## What will happen to your \$ When you are gone?

Our guest last week was John Wagner from the planned giving ministry of the Salvation Army. John came at the request of Pat Boyle to discuss estate planning. He said that 7 out of 10 people do not have a will of any kind. However, it is important to have a will and yours should be reviewed about every four years or whenever a significant life event happens.

The Salvation Army has a website that will help you plan your will. The site and the planning are free and there is no obligation to name the SA in your will in order to access the site. Log on to www.salpg.org and follow the directions to gather the information needed to complete your will. When you are done, you can print the information for your lawyer or have it sent to one on the approved lawyers list.

It is important to consider how and to whom your assets will be distributed following your death. If you do not make those decisions, the state will appoint someone who will. Not only will that be a costly mistake financially; but, your assets may not be cared for the way you want. So, regardless of whether you intend to leave anything to charity or not, it is important to make a will and to keep it in a safe place.
