Extending Arms of Love

Don Brandt made a rare appearance last week in order to present his guest, Joy Martin, from Arms of Love Ministries. Arms of Love has three primary ministries, "Options Now" which is a crisis pregnancy ministry, "Man Up" which is directed toward building men of character who will be good husbands and fathers, and the "Peace Ministry" which helps to bring healing to women who have had abortions.

Joy is a counselor/facilitator with the peace ministry which is housed at River Bend Family Ministries in Wood River. The Peace Ministry gathers women in small Bible study groups to help them to work through the grief associated with abortions.

Joy reminded us that 1 out of 3 women in America have had abortions, and 1 of 5 women who attend church regularly have had abortions. Since Roe v Wade, 52 million abortions have taken place in the US making the womb the most dangerous place to live in America.

Joy shared her story of her own abortions and how she found faith and peace to help her to recover. Her story is one of great pain and greater grace. She also does speaking in churches, schools, and in youth groups. Joy or one of the others from Arms of Love would be happy to speak for your group.
