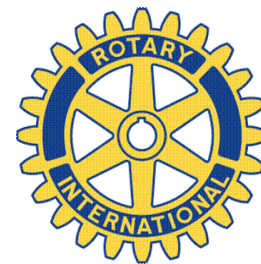




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 1/10/13

It was not voted on to give the money and will be discussed at a later time to give everyone a chance to understand the project and give input. The matching grants go away on March 31st.

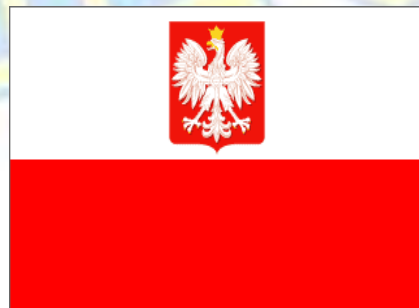
