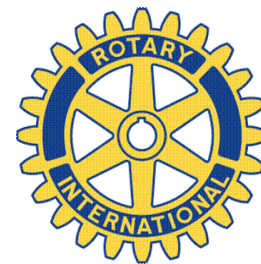




# TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 1/17/13

Thad was the youngest of 8 children and his sister, who was 12 years older than Thad, told him that when he became her age, he should be a Rotary Exchange Student and he kept that thought until he reached the age and did, indeed, become an Exchange Student and went to India. Thad was a participant in the first RYLA (Rotary Youth Leadership Awards) conference in 1983.

After graduating from Cornell's FALCON program, a full-year intensive language program in Japanese, and from a bachelor's degree program at SUNY Oneonta, he received an eighteen-month Paul Harris Graduate Scholarship to Japan, then remained in Japan, first as coordinator of international relations for Kagawa Prefecture, and then as executive director of that municipality's international exchange program, shepherding Japanese citizens to the U.S. as well as to Taiwan, Korea, and Thailand.

He returned to the U.S. and his family's real estate business, and is now vice president and general manager of RealtyUSA, New York's largest family-owned real estate company. He oversees 13 offices, 380 professionals and employees, and his teams did \$534 million in sales last year. In his free time, he travels the world. Thad shared some of the many pictures he took in his world travels.

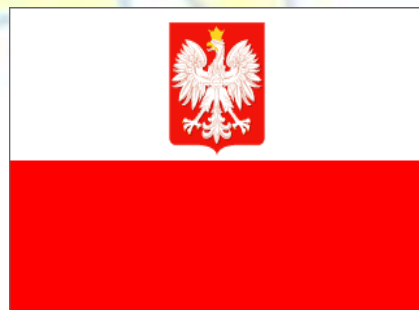
