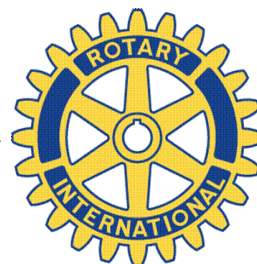




## TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 1/25/18

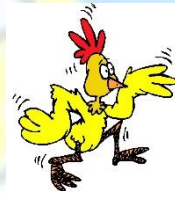
