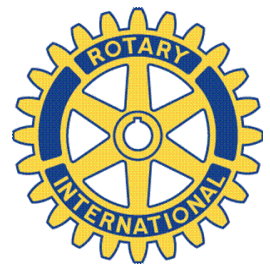




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 1/31/13

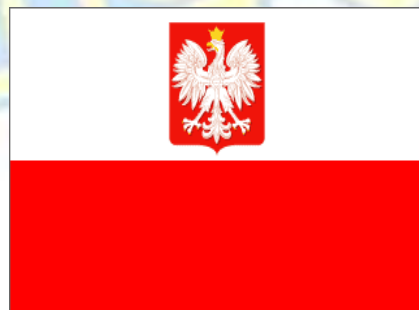
