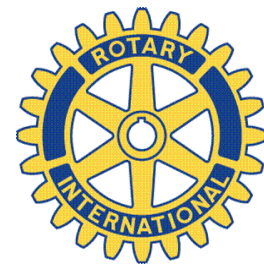




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 10/18/12

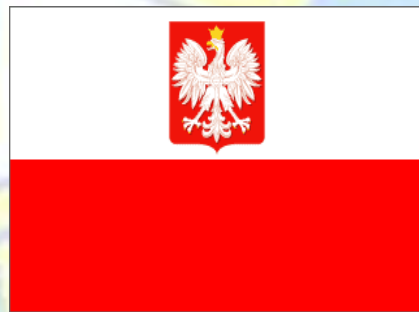
