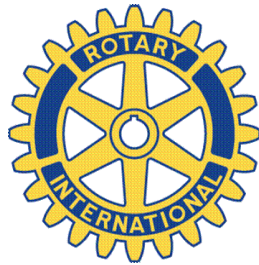




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 10/26/17

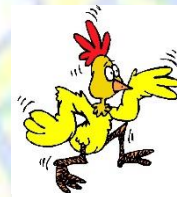
