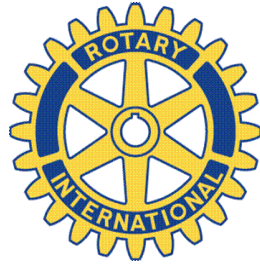




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 10/5/17
