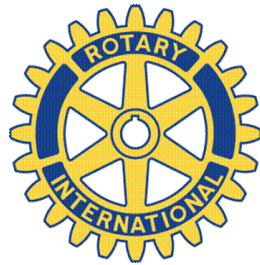

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 pm.



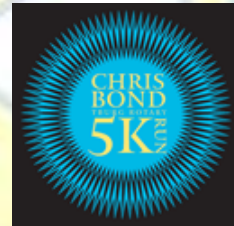
HAPPY DOLLARS
