An average funeral with a traditional burial in the U.S. can cost at least \$8,000 plus cemetery expenses. Planning what you want, documenting it and sharing it with your family can help them make decisions and control costs, making a painful time a little easier to bear.

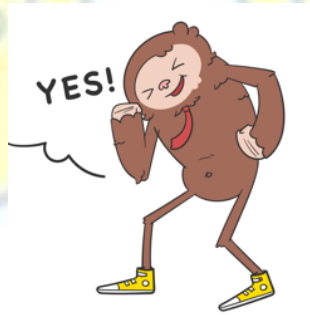
