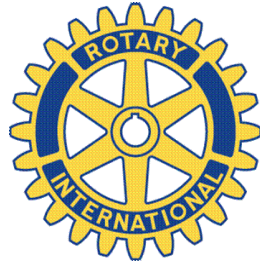




## TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 11/12/15
