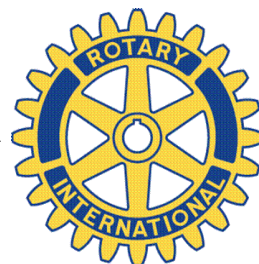




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 11/16/17
