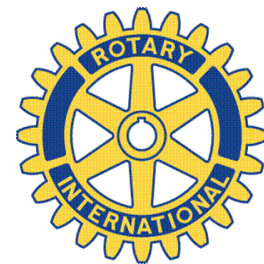




## TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 11/29/12

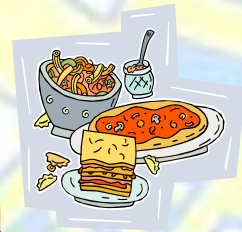
