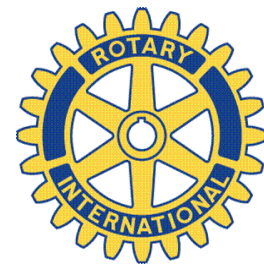




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 12/6/12

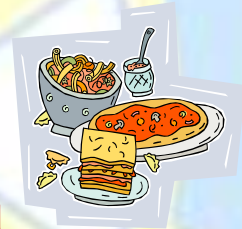
