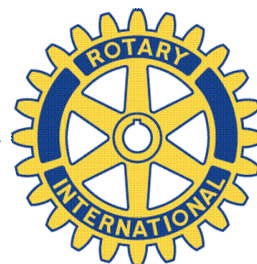




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 2/1/18
