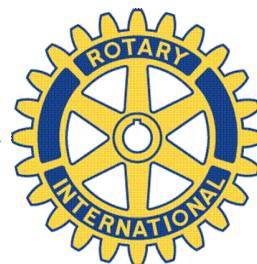




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 3/15/18

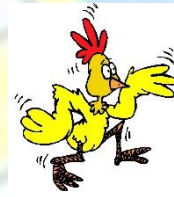
