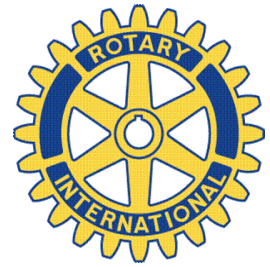




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 3/21/19
