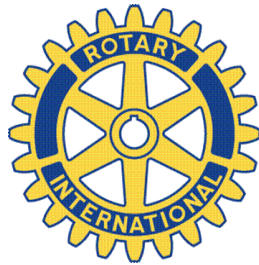




## TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 3/22/18

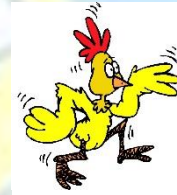
