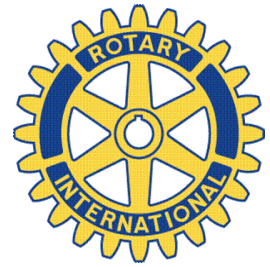




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 3/28/19
