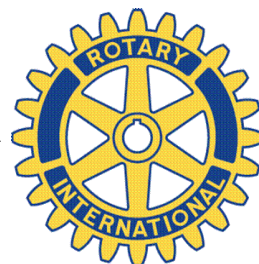




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 3/29/18
