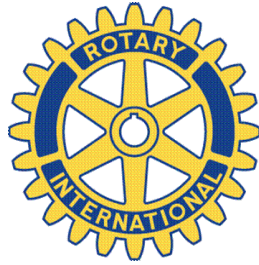




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 3/8/18

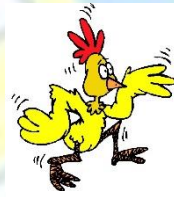
