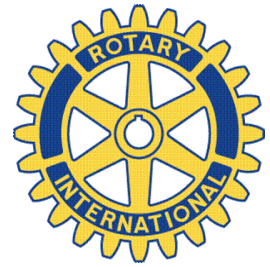




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 4/25/19
