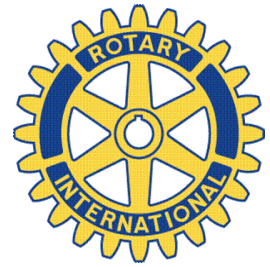




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 4/4/19

Tom Overbaugh then presented our speaker for the evening, Tom Ferretti, with the Paul Harris Fellow Award for his contributions to the community over many years of service as Police Chief and resident.



Ferretti then talked about his career. He joined the Navy and always wanted to be a police officer. So after he finished in the Navy he worked at Cornell in the Safety Division, then Deputy Sheriff of Tompkins County serving the Trumansburg area. In May of 1976 he became Police Chief of Trumansburg. As Chief he fired over 85 officers that all went on to good law enforcement jobs. Tom had the first low profile police car and the first to install cages in the police cars. He was also the first police department in Tompkins County to use body cams.

Tom has been married to his wife, Jackie, for 51 years and met her while he was a milkman serving a route in Newfield. They have lived in Trumansburg for 42 years.
