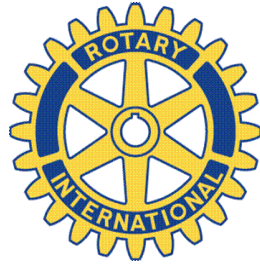

\$1 Shelly for happy the school tests are over.

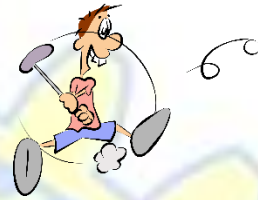
