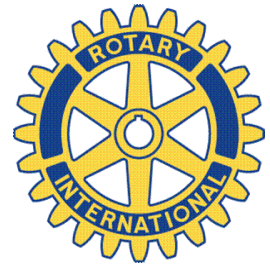




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 5/2/19
