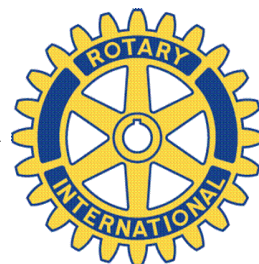




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 5/24/18
