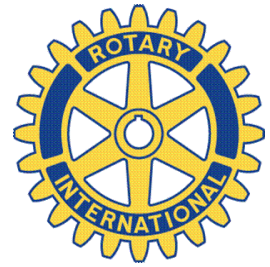




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 6/13/19
