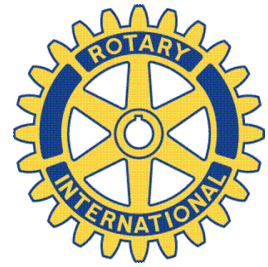




## TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 6/6/19
