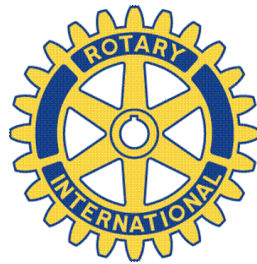




## TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 7/11/13
