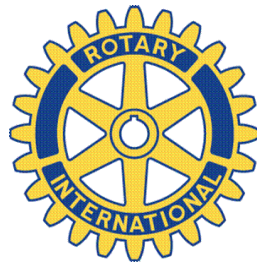

Editor's note....a special "Thank You" to Kathleen Overbaugh for doing the minutes for me.

The meeting was brought to order at 6:45.

President Shelly expressed gratitude to the club for everyone's help during her President's year, and passed the gavel to our new Club President, Zoren Bullock.



Ben Curtis reported on the golf tournament. 18 paying teams, 2 comp teams. Hole Sponsors, Maines, Premium Catering sponsored 1st prize, and Trumansburg Golf Course 2nd prize. Putting contest made \$280 and was very competitive. 50/50 earned about \$100-200, and Mulligan \$260. Ben expects we made about \$5000 this year. Maguire donated a car for hole in one prize, which no one claimed. Philip Maguire expressed an interest in having a Maguire person in our Rotary club. He would also like to give a different kind of sponsorship next year.

Mike Brainard sent a message that the left-over steaks need to be cooked soon. Bill will bring the grill next week for our dinner.

There was good support from the Bainbridge club, who will have their own golf tournament in a few weeks, so Ben encouraged Trumansburg members to sign up.

Martin Pritz – there will be a metal collection at Save-a-Lot parking lot July 20-21 for the Guatemala orphans at Casa Shalom, so drop off donations there, or send a check to FPCU – Guatemala orphans fund.

Tom announced that Cindy Kain was accepted by District as facilitator for RLI. Club agreed to cover her expenses. (Registration fee of \$170 and two nights hotel at \$99 per night). John Kotun made motion that the club cover her expenses, Bill Overbaugh seconded, all in favor.

Passed out Thank You letters for sponsorship of the Golf Tournament for members to deliver in person.

Bill reported that Alice Ploss is hosting a benefit for Katherine Sellers who will undergo heart surgery, to be held at Alice's home on August 3, and has asked us to do a chicken BBQ for them. He is looking for one or two more club members to help. Tom suggested that club have a policy that, in the future, we select the site and time for these benefits, or the group requesting the BBQ must cover the costs. If Alice wants this at her place, she should pay for the chicken and the \$15 permit fee, if necessary.

Just Be Cause fund raiser to benefit the Loaves and Fishes. Club decided to purchase two tickets (50 each), to be available for someone in the club to purchase. If no one purchases them, the \$100 will be a donation.

Zoren read a letter from Lana Rouf, our Foundation chair, who praised the Trumansburg club for contributing \$500 to Polio Plus this year, and \$7405.50 to the Rotary Foundation, and had a total per capita giving of \$411.

Zoren presented Paul Harris Fellow awards to John Kotun, Kathleen Overbaugh and Tom Overbaugh.



Zoren turned the meeting over to District Governor Tom Overbaugh, who spoke about “Engage Rotary, Change Lives” in a personal way, describing how he came to understand what Rotary was all about and how it changed his life.

Ben Curtis asked for help with the Triathlon on August 4 to manage the refreshment station at the Falls in the morning. **Any member who is willing to help, please contact Ben before next week's meeting.**

Ben reported that he's heard from his contact in Nepal about the Nepal education project and they are asking for a commitment from the club on our donation to the project. The club voted that we commit to \$2500.

Tom reminded members of Bill Cadwaller's memorial service in Homer on August 31 at 11AM.

Ben suggested club talk about membership expectations.

Zoren reminded the club to think about getting more people involved in the Youth Exchange program and invited everyone to the club officer's training meetings on July 20 and August 10.

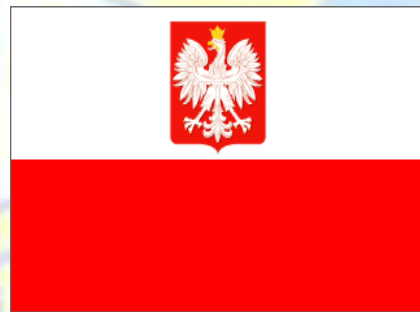
