There is also an appeal for prizes for the golf tournament which will be held next Friday. We are almost out of time and need to start soliciting now.

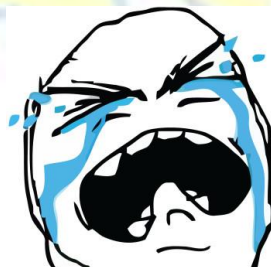
Dryden is still looking for a date to have a bowling match with our club in the new allies in Trumansburg. We will advise them to pick a Thursday in August for this.
