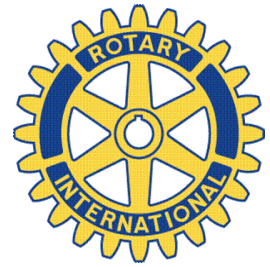




## TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 8/2/18

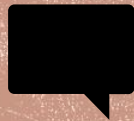


## HAPPY DOLLARS
