Shelly informed us that Harsha, our exchange student from India, will be coming in Wednesday, August 29th at 5:41 pm. It would be nice if we were there to greet him.

Zoren explained that it is vital that we all help to find host families or we will not be able to participate in this program and this is a vital part of Rotary. Just a suggestion of someone would help. You never know how it will work out. It does not have to be families with children and it can also be families with only one parent.

Melissa reported that she met with some women in Tanzania about the water and sanitation grant we are trying to get going. They were very receptive to the idea and we will be going forth with the project once we get all the pieces lined up.

Frank suggested we donate \$100 to CSI to help with the algae problem. All agreed.

Tom suggested that members with points to give, give 100 points towards a Paul Harris Fellow for Tom Ferritti.

\$3 from Kathleen for a great anniversary party, all four children were there, and all four children have gone back home.


\$1 from Frank for Dan Kidney being present.


September 27th
