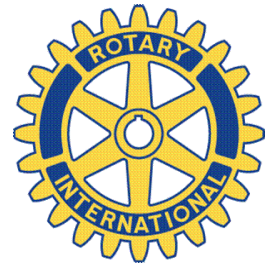




TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 8/9/18
