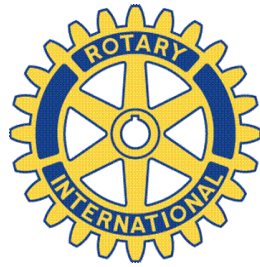




## TRUMANSBURG ROTARY MEETING MINUTES FOR 9/28/17

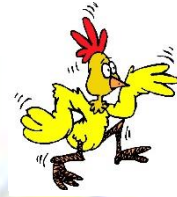
