**Speaker:** Carl Beardsley – Commissioner of Aviation, Greater Binghamton Airport



Carl gave us a fact filled and interesting overview of the Binghamton Airport. He said that 50% of their 25,000 flights were commercial airlines and the other 50% were general aviation – corporate jets, etc. He said that the airport supports 150 jobs of which 25 work directly under him. He estimates that the airport is responsible for \$52,000,000 of economic activity, making it an important component of the local economy. Perhaps most interesting is the geothermal project done in conjunction with B.U. which heats a portion of the tarmac when the planes disembark passengers to keep it free from ice and snow.


