Doug gave an update on Rotary's fight to eliminate polio which began in the 1980s when polio was present in 200 countries. The current Rotary International President, Robbie Ravindran of Sri Lanka, first became aware of Rotary when his mother (who had polio) was helped by treatment provided by Rotary. Polio now only exists in three countries – Nigeria, Afghanistan and Pakistan – and the plan is to eliminate it entirely by 2018.

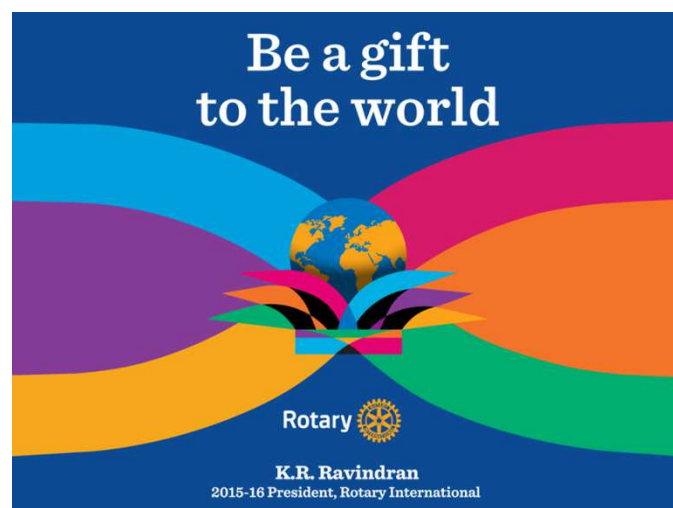
