Phase I is now completed which was taking care of the weaving patterns on the west side of the river. Phase II will eliminate the weaves that are remaining, build two new bridges, new pavements, a trail to Otsinengo Park and heading Front St, will have 3 lanes instead of 4. Noise walls will be installed on the Glenwood bridge deck currently heading west. An off ramp to the Stowe property area will also be incentive for development. The possibility of moving all traffic to the southbound lanes would speed up the project and save money.
