1) Broome's fund balance was very tight in 2017 meaning the money we had coming was almost identical to the money going out. Breaking even is fine but one wrong turn and we don't have a rainy day fund. 2018 they have reworked the budget to help save money and have a better fund balance.

2) Heroin epidemic. Broome is fighting the heroin epidemic and in February saw no overdose deaths from heroin. They have opened the 50 bed treatment center at the former Broome developmental building on the west side.

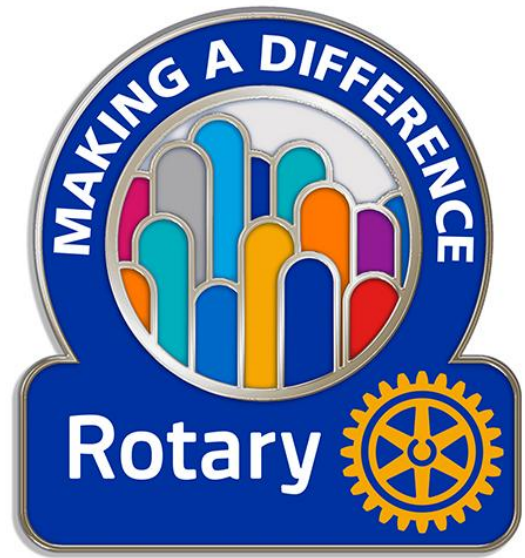
