Guest Speaker: Steve Cornwell,
Broome County District Attorney



Elected in 2015, Stephen (Steve) K. Cornwell Jr., became the 25th District Attorney of Broome County. Cornwell began his legal career in 2005 when he opened a solo law practice concentrating on both criminal and civil litigation. Cornwell previously served the office as an Assistant District Attorney from 2007-2009. He returned to private practice from 2009-2015 where he operated his own private practice.

Steve Cornwell is a graduate of Syracuse University School of Law (2004) and School of Management (2001). Cornwell also attended SUNY Broome (1997-1999). The DA's office prosecutes over 6800 cases per year from speeding tickets to murder. This is done with a 6 million dollar budget. This is done with only 26 prosecutors. Overall the crime rate is going down and the drug issues are starting to decrease. The DA's office is developing many diversion programs for the lower level crimes to work to help individuals build a life to learn skills and earn a living. This will decrease the recidivism rate.
