The undersigned natural person of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more who is a citizen of the State of Texas, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is LONGVIEW (GREGGTON) ROTARY CLUB OF LONGVIEW, TEXAS, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE THREE

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

(1.) The primary purpose for which the corporation is formed is charitable and benevolent and to encourage, promote and extend the objects of Rotary International, to maintain the relations of a member club in Rotary International, and to submit to the constitution and bylaws of Rotary International as they now exist and as may hereafter be amended.

(2.) The general purposes and powers are:

(a) To purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire, improve, construct, own, hold, use, maintain, operate, exchange, incumber, sell, convey, or otherwise dispose of, real and personal property of every kind, nature, or description, as may be necessary or desirable to promote the primary purpose of this corporation.

(b) To make or perform contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, state, government, or municipal or political subdivision.

(c) To have and exercise all the rights and powers conferred on non-profit corporations under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, as such law is now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended.

(d) To do all other acts necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs and attainment of the purposes of this corporation.

The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, and the purposes and powers stated in each clause shall, except for otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by any reference to or inference from the terms or provisions of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

(3) Notwithstanding any of the foregoing statements of purposes and powers, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this corporation as set forth in paragraph (1) of this Article Four, and nothing contained in the foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed to authorize this corporation to carry on any activity for the profit of its members, or to distribute any gains, profits, or dividends to its members as such, except on dissolution and winding up.

This corporation is organized pursuant to the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act and does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and is organized for non-profit purposes.

ARTICLE FIVE

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1605 Pineland, Longview, Texas 75604, and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is GENE ROBERTSON.

ARTICLE SIX

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is eight and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the board of directors are:
