

ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. The current applicant must have graduated from a Kerr county High School and is either currently attending or accepted into a college or vocational school and has maintained a 3.0 or B GPA or better
2. Applicant must fully complete the scholarship application form to be provided by Rotary Club of Kerrville.
3. Applicant must demonstrate involvement in civic, church or community related services.
4. Applicant must exemplify good character, integrity, responsibility, and leadership.
5. Applicant must be already be attending or accepted to an accredited college or vocational school prior to any funds being disbursed to the institution.
6. Applicant must be considered as a full time student at his/her college or vocational school before scholarship funds are released to the college/vocational school for the benefit of the applicant.
7. Scholarship funds can be used for tuition, boarding expenses, or fees.
8. The scholarship may be used for any field of study.
9. The applicant must be a Kerr County Resident
10. Partially filled out applications will be discarded. All questions must be answered.
